**The Dallas Foundation Awards Heart & Bones Rescue
\$25,000 Animal Welfare Grant**

Dallas, TX (July 7, 2023) – Hearts & Bones Animal Rescue is pleased to have received a \$25,000 grant from the Dallas Foundation’s Louis B. and Mary Ratliff Fund for Animal Welfare, to support their mission to save the lives of homeless dogs in Dallas and the surrounding area.

This fund rewards over \$300,000 in grants annually to organizations that promote the health and welfare of animals and is awarded by The Dallas Foundation, a non-profit organization that aims to provide philanthropists with flexible means for making donations to improve the Dallas community.
